Interaction between Kawasaki City and Haneda Area, Ota City

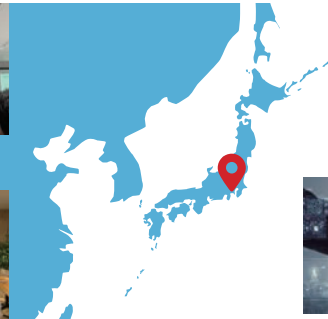


- Active exchanges are being held with each incubation facility in Kawasaki City through joint events and business matching.

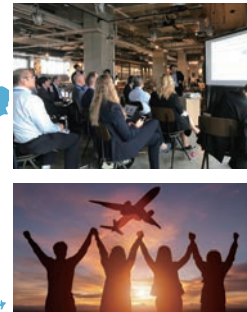
Interaction between domestic hubs

- We built a network between companies in Kanto region, universities, and cooperated institutions, etc. such as participating in Greater Tokyo Biocommunity and startup ecosystem Tokyo Consortium.
- Through collaborative events and mutual site visits with major domestic clusters and other organizations, we are promoting joint research and commercialization efforts by academia and businesses.



Interaction between overseas hubs

- We build new overseas networks and expand business exchanges by accepting visitors from embassies and bio-clusters, and by exchanging information online.
- We signed MOUs with BioM in Germany and GIP GENOPOLE in France and deepen these exchanges through joint events.

At KING SKYFRONT, we aim to create an ecosystem where new businesses are continuously created, from advanced R&D, through collaboration between companies from anywhere. We create an environment that facilitates startups'

activities by supporting their growth in cooperation with the world's top incubators, operating shared offices for those who wish to establish a base in the area, and maintaining the community lounge as a place for exchange and collaboration.

KING SKYFRONT

What is KING SKYFRONT?

KING SKYFRONT is an international strategic zone that aims to create new industries from world-class R&D in the life science and environmental fields. Since the Central Institute for Experimental Animals (Currently known as Central Institute for Experimental Medicine and Life Science) moved into the area in 2011, it has grown into a medical innovation area with approximately 80 research institutes and companies.

KING SKYFRONT

Kawasaki Innovation Gateway

"KING" is an acronym for "Kawasaki Innovation Gateway" and reflects the name of the town "Tono-machi" with "Tono" meaning "feudal lord". In addition, "SKYFRONT" is a reference to its close location to Haneda Airport, which connects Japan to the rest of the world, and is just across the Tama River.

1 World's Leading Open Innovation Hub

About 80 companies, academic, public research institutions, are in KING SKYFRONT, where the world's most advanced R&D related to drug discovery, medicine, medical equipment, is being conducted. We promote open innovation to create new industries by proactively networking a variety of multidisciplinary, institutions domestically and overseas.

2 R&D Center aiming social implementation of next-generation medicine

At KING SKYFRONT, R&D covers a wide range of fields. The institutions that develop cutting-edge animal testing areas and work on regulatory science and DDS research play a central role. A network for practical application and industrialization of regenerative medicine and cell therapy are formed as well.

3 A "face-to-face" hub that connects local institutions

At KING SKYFRONT, KING SKYFRONT Network Council centered on local institutions conducts joint projects to make the local area more attractive. These activities have created a "face-to-face" relationship with each other and lead to the creation of new businesses through collaboration.

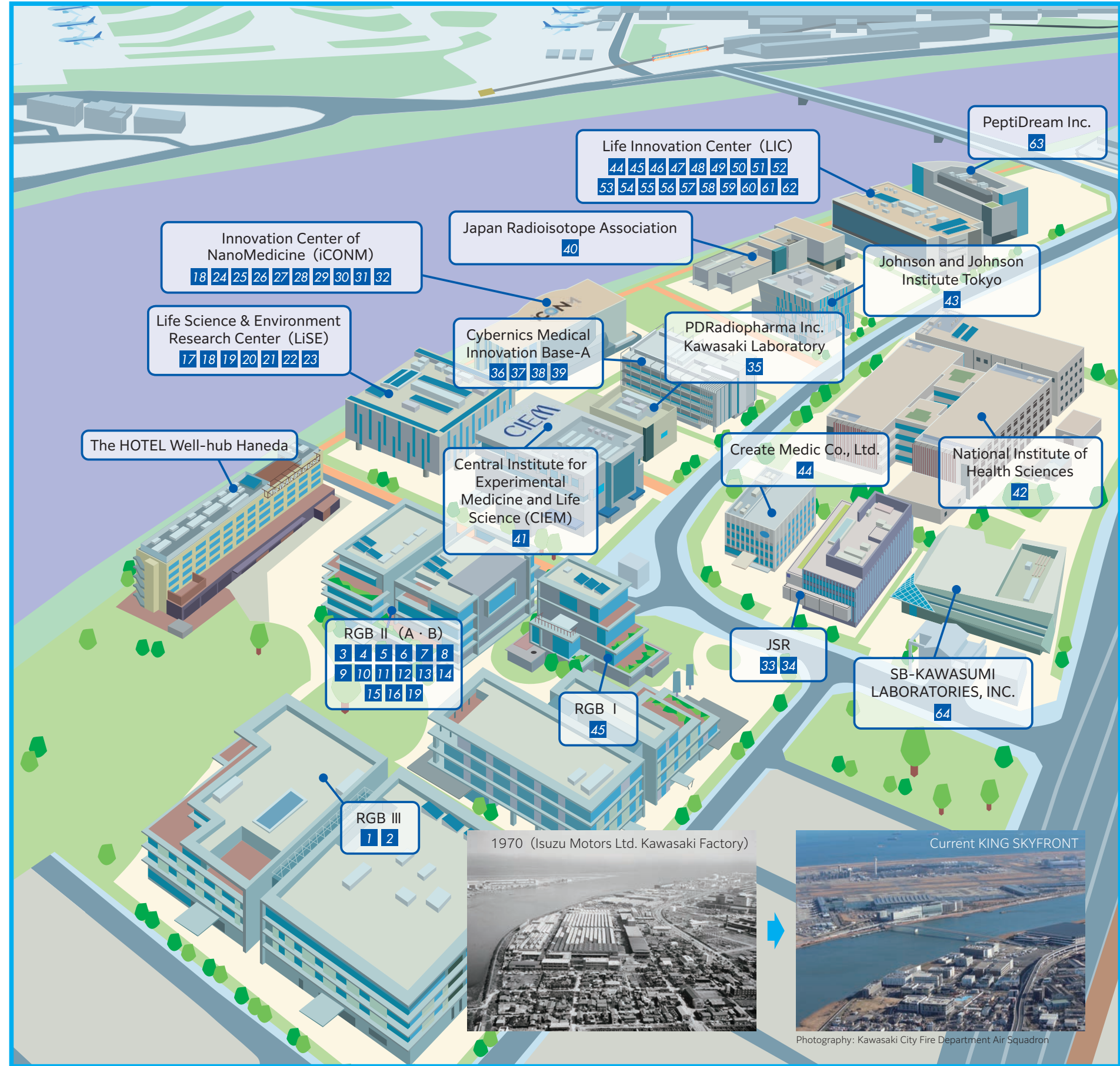
